Yannick Hanfmann (GER) vs Matteo Berrettini (ITA)

First Meeting

Yannick Hanfmann | Age: 32 | World No. 116 | Career-High No. 45 | 2024: 15-19 (Kitzbuhel SF) | Kitzbuhel: 10-5 (2020 Final)

- > Hearing-impaired player broke into Top 100 in 2018 and achieved career-high No. 45 in July 2023.
- > Earned biggest win of career over No. 5 Tsitsipas at 2023 Mallorca en route to 6th ATP Tour SF.
- > Defeated No. 9 Fritz in 2R and No. 6 Rublev in 4R to reach 1st ATP Masters 1000 QF at 2023 Rome.
- > Qualified en route to 1st ATP Tour final at 2017 Gstaad and 2nd final at 2020 Kitzbuhel.
- > Captured 1st Top 10 win of career over No. 9 Monfils at 2020 Hamburg, where he accepted main draw WC instead of playing qualifying at Roland Garros.
- > Posted 1st Grand Slam main draw win in 7th try at 2022 Australian Open as Q (d. Kokkinakis).
- > Captured 6 Challenger titles after playing for University of Southern California (2012-15), where he helped Trojans win 2 NCAA national titles.

NOTE: Hanfmann is seeking his 3rd ATP Tour final after 2017 Gstaad (I. to Fognini) and 2020 Kitzbuhel (I. to Kecmanovic). He aims to snap an 8-match losing streak vs. Top 50 since February after starting the year 4-2 and would return to the Top 100 on PIF ATP Live Rankings for the first time in a month with a semifinal win.

Matteo Berrettini | Age: 28 | World No. 50 | Career-High No. 6 | 2024: 19-5 (2 Titles) | Kitzbuhel: 5-1 (2024 SF) > Achieved career-high No. 6 after reaching 2022 Australian Open SF, becoming 3rd-highest-ranked Italian since start of PIF ATP Rankings in 1973 (No. 1 Sinner in 2024, No. 4 Panatta in 1976).

- > At 2021 Wimbledon, became 1st Italian men's singles finalist in tournament history and 1st Italian Grand Slam men's singles finalist since Panatta at 1976 Roland Garros.
- > First Italian man to reach QFs of all 4 Grand Slam events and 1st to earn a win at Nitto ATP Finals (d. Thiem in 2019 RR).
- > Owns 42-11 record on grass with 4 of his 9 ATP Tour titles, including 2021 and 2022 London/Queen's Club to become 1st player in Open Era to win titles in each of his 1st 2 appearances at that event.
- > Defeated No. 3 Thiem en route to 2021 ATP Cup team final and No. 3 Ruud en route to 2023 United Cup team final for biggest wins of career.

NOTE: Berrettini is on an 8-match winning streak after claiming the title in Gstaad (d. Halys) and is 8-0 in ATP Tour clay semifinals. He is 13-1 on clay this year, lone loss to Kecmanovic at ATP Masters 1000 Monte-Carlo in April and aims to be the 1st Italian finalist in Kitzbuhel since Lorenzi won the title in 2016.

Hugo Gaston | Age: 23 | World No. 91 | Career-High No. 58 | 2024: 8-9 (Kitzbuhel SF) | Kitzbuhel: 3-0 (2024 SF) > Broke into Top 100 after reaching 2021 ATP Masters 1000 Paris QF as Q, then achieved career-high No. 58 in July 2022.

- > Advanced to 1st ATP Tour QF, SF and final at 2021 Gstaad as World No. 155 and competed at Next Gen ATP Finals to end season.
- > At 2020 Roland Garros, became 1st Frenchman to reach 4R in tournament debut since Dominguez in 1971, defeating 2015 champion Wawrinka in 5 sets before falling in 5 sets to 2-time finalist Thiem.
- > As 239th-ranked WC, became lowest-ranked player to reach Grand Slam 4R since No. 248 Canas at 2004 Australian Open and Roland Garros 4R since No. 283 Di Pasquale in 2002.
- > Ended 2018 as World No. 2 junior after winning gold medal in boys' singles and bronze medal in both boys' doubles and mixed doubles at Youth Olympics.

NOTE: Gaston saved 2 MPs vs Baez in QF and seeks his 2nd ATP Tour final after 2021 Gstaad (I. to Ruud). He is 6-1 against Argentinians on tour-level, lone loss to Baez at 2021 Next Gen ATP Finals. The 23-year-old aims to be the 1st French finalist in Kitzbuhel since Mathieu in 2015 (I. to Kohlschreiber).

- **F. Diaz Acosta** | Age: 23 | World No. 77 | Career-High No. 47 | 2024: 15-12 (Buenos Aires Title) | Kitzbuhel: 3-0 (2024 SF) > Left-handed Argentine climbed to career-high No. 47 in April 2024 after advancing to his 3rd and biggest ATP Tour QF in Barcelona.
- > In his hometown Buenos Aires, made ATP Tour debut in 2020 as a WC, captured 1st ATP Tour win in 2023 (d. Coria) and advanced to 1st SF and final en route to 1st ATP Tour title in 2024.
- > Defeated compatriots Gomez and Tirante to reach 1st ATP Tour QF at 2024 Cordoba (I. to compatriot Baez).
- > Owns 82-53 Challenger record (5-3 in finals), 44-17 in 2023, earning titles at 2022 Coquimbo, 2023 Savannah, Oeiras-4, Milan and Montevideo.
- > Former World No. 6 junior ended junior career in Buenos Aires by earning singles silver medal and doubles gold medal with countryman Baez at 2018 Youth Olympics.

NOTE: Diaz Acosta is seeking his 2nd ATP Tour final after claiming the Buenos Aires title in February (d. Jarry). He has earned 16 of his 17 career tour-level wins on clay, including all 15 in 2024. The winner of this semifinal will become the first left-hander to reach the Kitzbuhel final since Ramos-Vinolas in 2019 (I. to Thiem).
