Kecmanovic 2020 Summary | Age: 21 | World No. 47 | 13-6 in 2020 (Kitzbühel Finalist) | 4-0 in Kitzbühel (Finalist)

- #NextGenATP Serbian US Open made resumption to tour at US Open and beat Mager in five sets in 1R before losing to Bautista Agut. This week in Kitzbuhel debut posted wins over [6] Nishikori in 3 sets, Thompson 62 62 along with [Q] Delbonis and [Q] Huesler both in 3 sets.
- The No. 4 Serb is appearing in his second career ATP Tour final (2019 Antalya, l. to Sonogo).
- Has won 46 of 54 service games (85%) this week, saving 9 of 17 break pts. and 18 of 53 return games (34%).
- Fell to eventual champions in 2nd ATP Tour SF at Doha (l. to Rublev) and 3rd SF at New York (l. to Edmund).
- Also lost to eventual champion Nadal in Acapulco 2R and advanced to Delray Beach 2R (l. to Humbert).
- Returned to career-high No. 47 in FedEx ATP Rankings on 2 March.

- Following tour resumption, won title at Todi, ITA Challenger (d. Zapata Miralles) and 2R at Trieste, ITA Challenger (l. to Vilella Martinez). Qualified and beat Bublik on Wednesday for 1st ATP Tour win since 2018 Munich and followed with 3-set victory over [3] Lajovic and straight sets over [Q] Marterer and 3rd set TB over [Q] Djere.
- Bidding to become the first player to win on both the ATP Tour and ATP Challenger Tour in 2020. He prevailed in Todi to open the restart in August. Note: #NextGenATP Brazilian Thiago Seyboth Wild can also achieve the feat on Sunday. The champion in Santiago in February is in the final at the Aix-en-Provence, FRA Challenger.
- Trying to become first qualifier to win Kitzbuhel title since Martin Klizan (d. Q-Istomin) two years ago.
- Has won 42 of 51 service games (82%) this week, saving 6 of 15 break pts. and 16 of 49 return games (33%).
- Appearing in first ATP Tour final since July 2017 when he was a finalist in Gstaad (l. to Fognini) as a qualifier.
- Also reached the final at Burnie, AUS Challenger in February, losing to Daniel.

DOUBLES CHAMPIONSHIP

[1] Marcel Granollers (ESP) / Horacio Zeballos (ARG) vs. First Meeting
[4] Austin Krajicek (USA) / Franko Skugor (CRO)

- **Granollers** and **Zeballos** have not dropped a set this week (6-0) en route to their third ATP Tour final of the season. In February they won back-to-back titles in Buenos Aires and Rio de Janeiro. They have a 28-9 career record together (3-1 in finals), including 15-4 this season. **Granollers** is ranked No. 15 and is 20-20 in career finals. The Spaniard's last ATP Tour singles title came in Kitzbühel in 2013. **Zeballos** is ranked No. 4 and 15-11 in finals.

- **Krajicek** and **Skugor** have reached their first ATP Tour final together by winning all three matches in a Match Tie-break this week. They have a 7-4 career record since first teaming up in Auckland (SF) in January. **Krajicek** is ranked No. 39 and 3-5 in ATP Tour finals. His last title came in Atlanta last July. **Skugor** is ranked No. 33 and is 5-3 in finals. The Croat's last title came at ATP Masters 1000 Monte-Carlo in April 2019.

GENERALI OPEN TALKING POINTS

- This is the first European tournament on the ATP Tour since February in Marseille.
- No. 1 seed **Fabio Fognini** is playing in his first event since having surgery on both ankles at the end of May. The Italian No. 2 played his last ATP event in Dubai and has been practicing with coach Corrado Barazzutti during the last few weeks. He reached the semifinals in his most recent appearance in Kitzbuhel in 2017 (l. to eventual champion Kohlschreiber).
- No. 2 seed **Diego Schwartzman** has a 5-1 record on clay this year, with his best results coming on home-soil in Cordoba (F, l. to Garin) and Buenos Aires (SF, l. to P. Sousa). The top Argentine is 2-2 in Kitzbuhel with 2R finishes in 2014-15.
- World No. 24 and No. 3 seed **Dusan Lajovic** is appearing for the 6th straight time in the Austrian Alps. The Serbian No. 2 won his first ATP Tour title in 2019 on clay in Umag. Kicked off the season by reaching the final of the ATP Cup with Serbia, scoring a 4-2 record in singles.
- No. 6 seed **Kei Nishikori** is making his comeback after undergoing right elbow surgery in October 2019. The former World No. 4 is appearing at the Kitzbuhel Tennis Club for the first time, a year after his last match at the US Open (3R, l. to de Minaur).
