Aslan Karatsev | Age: 29 | World No. 39 | Career-High No. 14 | 2022: 15-25 (Sydney Title) | Career: 52-55 (3 Titles) > Broke into Top 20 after winning 2nd ATP Tour title at 2021 Moscow, then achieved career-high No. 14 following 3rd title at 2022 Sydney.

- > Reached 2021 Australian Open SF as World No. 114, becoming 1st men's semi-finalist in Grand Slam debut in Open Era, 1st men's qualifier to reach Grand Slam SF since Voltchkov at 2000 Wimbledon, and lowest-ranked Grand Slam men's semi-finalist since No. 125 Ivanisevic at 2001 Wimbledon.
- > Ended 23-match ATP 500 win streak of countryman Rublev en route to 1st ATP Tour title at 2021 Dubai, then defeated No. 1 Djokovic at 2021 Belgrade-1 and No. 2 Medvedev at 2021 Rome.
- > In mixed doubles w/Vesnina, finished as 2021 Roland Garros runner-up and 2020 Tokyo Olympics silver medallist in All-ROC final (held in 2021).
- > Went 18-2 on ATP Challenger Tour from August-November 2020, including titles at Prague-2 and Ostrava.

NOTE: Karatsev is 1-9 in his last 10 matches (d. Nakashima in 2022 ATP Masters 1000 Cincinnati in 1R). He is 9-14 on hard courts in 2022 after a 6-0 start (Sydney title, Australian Open 3R).

Tallon Griekspoor | Age: 26 | World No. 54 | Career-High No. 44 | 2022: 17-21 (3 times in QF) | Career: 24-36 (3 QFs) > Achieved career-high No. 44 in after winning 11th Challenger title of career at 2022 Amersfoort.

- > Went 8-0 in finals and 42-7 overall on ATP Challenger Tour in 2021, setting single-season record for most titles and ending season with 25 straight wins.
- > Advanced to ATP Tour QFs on 3 different surfaces at Melbourne, Geneva and Mallorca in 2022.
- > Rallied from a set down for Rotterdam 1R wins as WC over No. 13 Wawrinka in 2018, No. 11 Khachanov in 2019 and No. 14 Karatsev in 2022.
- > Twin brothers, Scott and Kevin, are 5.5 years older and peaked at No. 205 and No. 655 respectively in Pepperstone ATP Rankings.

NOTE: Griekspoor holds a 5-13 record vs. Top 50 players on tour-level hard courts in his career.

Daniel Elahi Galan | Age: 26 | World No. 71 | Career-High No. 69 | 2022: 11-10 (2 times in QF) | Career: 34-33 (2 SFs) > Improved year-end ranking in 7 straight seasons (2015-21), then broke into Top 100 in July 2022 before achieving career-high No. 69 in September 2022.

- > Defeated 2-time defending champion Johnson en route to 1st ATP Tour QF and SF at 2019 Houston as Q-WC.
- > Advanced to 1st Grand Slam 3R at 2020 Roland Garros as LL and 1st ATP Masters 1000 3R at 2021 Miami.
- > Won ATP Tour main draw debut on home soil at 2015 Bogota as 19-year-old WC (d. Riba).
- > Owns 106-96 Challenger record (4-3 in finals), including clay-court titles in 2022 at Concepcion and Sarasota.

NOTE: Galan is 4-1 vs. lower-ranked players on tour-level in 2022.

- **R. Carballes Baena** | Age: 29 | World No. 80 | Career-High No. 69 | 2022: 8-16 (2 times in QF) | Career: 71-94 (1 Title) > Former World No. 8 junior achieved career-high No. 71 in November 2021 following previous career-high of No. 72 in February 2018.
- > At 2018 Quito, became 1st Spanish qualifier to win an ATP Tour title since Almagro at 2006 Valencia.
- > Earned biggest win of career over No. 11 Shapovalov 8-6 in 5th after 5 hours to reach 2020 Roland Garros 3R.
- > Defeated Goffin for 1st ATP Tour win en route to 2014 Casablanca SF as Q.
- > Boasts 227-144 Challenger record (10-8 in finals), capturing most recent title at 2022 Seville in the 2nd week of US Open.

NOTE: Carballes Baena is 1-6 on tour-level hard courts this season (d. Munar at 2022 US Open 1R).

J.J. Wolf (USA) vs [WC] Francesco Maestrelli (ITA)

First Meeting

- J.J. Wolf | Age: 23 | World No. 75 | Career-High No. 72 | 2022: 10-10 (Washington QF) | Career: 12-16 (1 QF)
- > Already ranked No. 272 when he turned pro in July 2019, then broke into Top 100 and achieved career-high No. 72 in September 2022.
- > Advanced to 1st ATP Tour QF at 2022 Washington as WC in his 1st week as a Top-100 player.
- > Achieved first Top 20 win over No. 18 Bautista Agut en route to 2nd Grand Slam 3R at 2022 US Open.
- > Made Grand Slam main draw debut and earned 1st tour-level wins of career en route to 2020 US Open 3R as WC (d. Pella and Carballes Baena).
- > Owns 78-42 Challenger record overall, including 5-1 in finals and 21-7 with 2 titles in Columbus, where he played 3 seasons of college tennis for Ohio State University.
- > Former World No. 18 junior won 2016 USTA Boys' 18s National Championship in doubles w/McNally and reached 2017 singles final at same event (I. to Kypson in 5 sets).

NOTE: Nine of Wolf's 10 Tour-level wins in 2022 have come in events held in the U.S.A. (d. Sonego at Acapulco 1R).

Francesco Maestrelli | Age: 19 | World No. 186 | Career-High No. 178 | 2022: 0-0 (Verona CH Title) | Career: 0-0 > After starting 2022 ranked out of Top 750, he achieved career-high No. 178 in September after making his 4th ATP Challenger semi-final of 2022 in Cassis.

- > Reached Q3 at 2022 US Open in his Grand Slam qualifying debut before squandering a 6-2 lead in the final set tiebreak (to 10) vs Borges.
- > Earned biggest career win over No. 75 Lestienne at 2022 Cassis CH QF and holds a 2-0 record vs. Top 100 players on the ATP Challenger Tour.
- > Owns 19-14 Challenger record (19-12 in 2022), coming through qualifying to win 1st Challenger title at 2022 Verona defeating No. 98 Cachin in the final from a set down stopping his 9-match winning streak.
- > Made his main draw debut at 2022 Florence as a wildcard.

NOTE: Maestrelli is making his tour-level debut after receiving a wildcard. He is one of 6 #NextGenATP players in the draw, currently No. 19 on Pepperstone ATP Live Race To Milan in hopes of qualifying for 2022 Intesa Sanpaolo Next Gen ATP Finals.

[WC] Giulio Zeppieri (ITA) vs [Q] Altug Celikbilek (TUR)

First Meeting

Giulio Zeppieri | Age: 20 | World No. 170 | Career-High No. 136 | 2022: 3-3 (Umag SF) | Career: 3-5 (1 SF)

- > Earned 1st ranking point at age 16 in July 2018 and achieved career-high No. 136 at age 20 in August 2022 after advancing to 1st ATP Tour SF at 2022 Umag.
- > Qualified at 2022 Roland Garros in 1st try at a Grand Slam event, defeating 38-year-old Seppi in Q1 to snap his countryman's streak of 66 straight Grand Slam main draw appearances.
- > Also qualified at 2022 ATP Masters 1000 Rome with comeback wins over No. 47 Molcan and No. 62 Cressy.
- > Captured 1st Challenger title of career on home soil at 2021 Barletta.
- > Peaked at No. 12 in juniors after falling to countryman Musetti in 2019 Australian Open boys' singles SF and teaming with Musetti to reach 2019 Australian Open boys' doubles SF.

NOTE: Zeppieri got all 3 of his career tour-level wins en route to his 1st ATP Tour SF at 2022 Umag (0-4 at other tour-level events). He is No. 16 on Pepperstone ATP Live Race To Milan.

Altug Celikbilek | Age: 26 | World No. 230 | Career-High No. 154 | 2022: 2-1 (Davis Cup) | Career: 10-10 (3 2Rs)

- > Broke into Top 200 in July 2021 after winning 1st ATP Challenger title at 2021 Porto and achieved a career-high No. 154 in February 2022.
- > Improved year-end ranking in 6 straight seasons from 2015-21, ending last season at year-end best No. 162.
- > Defeated former World No. 10 Gulbis in ATP Tour main draw debut at 2019 Antalya.
- > Owns 7-6 Davis Cup singles record for Turkey, highlighted by tie-clinching win vs. Denmark in 2019 (d. Sigsgaard).
- > Holds a 65-61 Challenger record with 3 titles at 2021 Porto, 2021 Pozoblanco and 2022 Porto, successfully defending the title.

NOTE: Celikbilek seeks 1st ATP Tour win of the season and first since 2021 Singapore (d. Mochizuki in 1R).

[Q] Flavio Cobolli (ITA) vs Corentin Moutet (FRA)

First Meeting

Flavio Cobolli | Age: 20 | World No. 164 | Career-High No. 133 | 2022: 0-1 (Rome 1R) | Career: 1-2 (1 2R)

- > Broke into Top 200 in January 2022 and achieved career-high No. 133 in July 2022 after finishing 2020 at No. 906.
- > Saved 3 MPs vs. Giron to win ATP Tour main draw debut 3-6 7-6 7-6 at 2021 Parma as 429th-ranked WC.
- > Has a 23-17 record (21-15 on clay) on ATP Challenger Tour this season and won 1st Challenger title at 2022 Zadar after reaching finals at 2021 Rome-2 and 2021 Barletta.
- > Captured 1st ITF World Tennis Tour title of career at Antalya in April 2021.
- > Peaked at No. 8 in juniors and ended career by winning 2020 Roland Garros boys' doubles title w/Stricker.
- > Has a 55-38 career Challenger record. including 49-30 on clay.

NOTE: Cobolli is playing in his first hard court tour-level match. He owns a 6-8 hard court record on the ATP Challenger circuit and 2-6 indoors.

Corentin Moutet | Age: 23 | World No. 69 | Career-High No. 64 | 2022: 10-8 (Adelaide-2 SF) | Career: 40-52 (1 Final) > Former Top-10 junior broke into Top 100 in 2019 and achieved career-high No. 64 in September 2022 after reaching 4R at US Open.

- > Reached 1st ATP Tour final as 20-year-old at 2020 Doha, becoming youngest French finalist on tour since Gasquet, 20, at 2006 Lyon.
- > Entered the draw as a lucky loser at 2022 US Open before advancing to 4R for the first time in his career at a Grand Slam (I. to Ruud).
- > Advanced to 3R at 2019 Roland Garros and 2020 US Open, then lost to Giustino after 6:05 in 2020 Roland Garros 1R longest match at event in 16 years.
- > Defeated future World No. 3 Tsitsipas for 1st of his 6 Challenger titles at 2017 Brest as WC.
- > Enjoys rapping and playing piano, having released an 8-song EP entitled "Ecorche" in 2020.

NOTE: Moutet is playing in his first tour-level event since making 4R at 2022 US Open as a lucky loser.
